CCAC graduates who have earned the AS in Health and Physical Education are guaranteed admission to Slippery Rock and to the BSED program if they have earned a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher and maintain SRU GPA of 2.5 (overall) and 2.8 in their major and are in good standing at the last institution attended.

Bachelor of Science in Nursing (3+1)

CCAC graduates who have earned the AS in Nursing are guaranteed admission to Slippery Rock and to the Nursing program if they have earned a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher and are in good standing at all institutions attended. Students can take an additional 24 credits in addition to AS program requirements and will transfer into SRU at the senior level.
